 sang hymn No. 112. On Jordan
 Sturdy was called to stand page 320
 No. 112.

9 We carry no umbrella.

10 We carry no man with 2 wives

- 11 We carry no unclean person
- 12 we agreed to administer the Lords
supper and wash feet monthly
- 13 We agree to preach the Gospel to
all people alike.
- 14 We baptize by immersion.
- 15 we have taken the Bible for
our discipline.

On the 27 day of our Lord 1877
Cong. Smith County Church
Ga.

All committee testified
to this end. After the rules
were composed and read, we
sang a hymn. I, M. do preach my
Gospel, with the word, but did
while each my Grace receive, etc.
After singing prayer was offered
by Bro Pitts & Pray was made
in defence of the: That the
Lord bless the church for
ever and ever amen.
